RESOLUTION 87

WHEREAS, Vincent Arjin Muller was born on September 22, 1941, to Bera Jatios Muller and Henry Muller from Majuro Atoll. The late Vincent Arjin Muller had passed on February 14, 2023.; and

WHEREAS, the late Vincent Arjin Muller belongs to the Rimwejor Jowi from his mother's side and Rikoro Jowi from his father's side. His father Henry Muller married to his mother Bera Jatios in Majuro in 1929, and has six (6) children, namely and in order as follows: 1) Helena Line Myazoe (deceased); 2) Charles Muller (deceased); 3) Roselind Batol; 4) Vincent; 5) Angelina Songsong; and 6) Phillip Muller; and

WHEREAS, the late Vincent Arjin Muller attended primary school at Rita Elementary School and Assumption Elementary School in Majuro. He attended his high school at the Xavier High School in Chuuk, and attended the Chaminade University in Honolulu, Hawaii. He began his carrier with the Ministry of Finance and had worked for over 30 years, both on Ebeye and Majuro. He steadily built his career over the years and became the third Secretary of Finance for the RMI. He later moved to the Marshall Islands National Telecommunications Authority, where he was the Controller until he retired at the age of 62 years; and

WHEREAS, the late Vincent Arjin Muller is survived by his wife of 53 years, Philomena Asma Shimizu Muller. They have 9 children in order are as follows: 1) Bobby Muller; 2) Maria Muller; 3) Eugene Muller; 4) Loreen Bigler; 5) Claudia Palmore; 6) Berry Muller; 7) Arsima Muller; 8) Jennifer Muller (deceased); 9) Valerie Muller. They also have 17 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren; and


